## Parents: To View Student State Summative Assessments

Students in grades three through eight participate in the California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress. Student Score Reports can be accessed electronically through the parent portal in PowerSchool.


The assessment reports that can be accessed are:

CAASPP (ELA/Math/Science)
California Science Test (CAST)
ELPAC Summative Assessment (SA)
ELPAC Initial Assessment (IA)


**NOTE**: Only reports that the student has taken will be available to be viewed.

If a parent would like to view their student's score reports they should follow the steps below.


1. In a web browser (Google, Firefox, Safari...) enter the following web address in the web browsers URL: **powerschool.central.k12.ca.us/public** and log in with the parents PowerSchool login information.



2. On the left hand side of the window select the option "Score Reports".




3. Using the "Assessment" pull down, select which assessment you would like to view. **Note**: it is helpful to select "All" because not all assessments are given to every student.



- 4. Using the "Year" pull down, select which year that you would like to view.

  Note: it is helpful to select "All". All years are not available for every student. If you do not get a result, the student may not have been tested in that time period.
- 5. Click the "Get Report" button.



6. Click the blue "View" link to load the assessment report.
